Crating available:

Car crating or ample crating outdoors on grass, but no shade. Please be prepared to protect yourself and your dog from sun!

Entry Limits:

500 runs maximum per day

Move ups:

Move-ups will be accepted until 1 hour after the last class of the day before the move-up. Please notify the trial secretary in writing of all move-ups ASAP. Email notifications are acceptable.

Day-of-Show Entries:

Day-of-Show entries accepted if entry limit is not met. Be prepared to list all attendees you are bringing.

Refunds:

Dogs may be withdrawn from one or more classes and receive a full refund provided written notification is given to the trial secretary by 9 PM on the Saturday one week prior to the trial. After that date, refunds will only be granted for bitches in heat, ill/injured dogs or handlers, and otherwise ineligible dogs/handlers. In such cases, a refund of entry fees, less \$4.00 per run to cover secretary, recording, & judge's fees, will be returned provided the trial secretary is given written notification prior to the beginning of judging for the day.

Food info:

No food will be provided on site. There are several restaurants within 5 miles of the trial site.

Volunteer info:

This trial is only possible because of our wonderful volunteer workers. A volunteer schedule will be available for signups at the trial.

Awards and Ribbons:

Placement ribbons will be awarded to 4th place in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances, which is a pass/fail class. A purple qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class. Title ribbons will be available for each title completed at this trial. A rosette will be awarded to any dog earning a NATCH at the trial. Please notify the trial secretary at least one week before the start of the trial if you expect to earn a NATCH at this trial.

Equipment info:

The following obstacles may be used in this trial: open tunnels, winged jumps, non-winged jumps, matted A-frame, matted dog walk, weave poles with 24" spacing, barrels, and hoops.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up-to-date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank-returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. Register your dog at <https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/>
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
 - 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
 - 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
 - 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
 - 1.5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **Four Paws Rule** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and C. Gordon Jewett and Teresa K. Jewett and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
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Four Paws Rule, its members, and the owners of the show premises, will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, for the loss or damage to the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. It is also distinctly understood that any persons being guests of the signing exhibitor are the sole responsibility of that exhibitor and thus bound by this agreement. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior shall, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

- **Dogs must be on leash at all times** (except during runs and in the warm-up area).
- **Please clean up after your dogs.**
- **PLEASE DO NOT LET YOUR DOG HARASS THE LIVESTOCK.**

ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELATING TO CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19

This Form must be completely filled out by each attendee and participant, including children.

The novel Coronavirus ("COVID-19") has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies have recommended social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited or limited the congregation of groups of people. From I-90: Take the Otis Orchards/Liberty Lake exit and head north until you reach Wellesley (blinking red light). Turn right (east) on Wellesley. Take the first left after you top a small rise (Malvern). Head north on Malvern to the trial site at North 6010 Malvern.

From East Trent: Turn left (south) on Starr Rd at Moab Junction Head south to Dalke. Turn right (west) on Dalke and go to Malvern. Turn left (south) on Malvern and drive to trial site on left at North 6010 Malvern.

From West Trent: Take right (south) on McKenzie. Turn left (east) on Joseph. Turn left (north) on Malvern and drive to the trial site at North 6010 Malvern.

Other trial information

There are cattle and a horse on the property, in close proximity to the trial site. Please keep your dogs under control. Any person or dog harassing the livestock will be asked to leave the show site, with no refund of trial fees.

We are sorry to not be able to host our usual Saturday evening barbecue at this trial.

If there are wildfires nearby, air quality may be an issue. If the Air Quality Index goes above 200 into the categories Very Unhealthy or Hazardous, the trial will be cancelled for the day. An announcement will be made on our website.

FOUR PAWS RULE COVID-19 POLICIES

We will abide by all federal, state and local regulations and guidance in effect regarding COVID-19 at the time of the trial.

We encourage everyone who can do so to be vaccinated by the time of the trial. This will help make it safer for those of us who cannot get vaccinated to attend the trial.

If you feel sick, please stay home. The hosting club reserves the right to excuse anyone who is coughing or showing other signs of illness.

Please list all attendees in your party on your entry form. ALL attendees must sign the COVID assumption of release/waiver of liability form. Submit this form with your entry.

Please bring your own food; no food will be provided by the host club.

Overnight camping will be permitted.

Handlers may wear or pocket their leash during their runs. Otherwise, leashes will be placed by the leash runner on a chair near the end of the run.
